The Keynote speaker for this meeting will be **Dennis Badger**. He is a current member of the Appraisal Standards Board and previously was a Consultant/Investigator at Kentucky Real Estate Appraisers Board, Instructor and developer of the Appraiser Regulatory Agency Investigator Training Course (Levels 1 & 2) for The Appraisal Foundation/Association of Appraiser Regulatory Officials/Appraisal Subcommittee. Dennis also was part of the Best Practices for Supervising Appraisers Task Force for The Appraisal Foundation, State Regulator Advisory Group to the Appraisal Foundation, and has been a Subject Matter Expert and an Appraisal Course Reviewer for the AQB’s Course Approval Program (CAP) from 2004 to present. He is currently an AQB Certified USPAP instructor and is Vice President of Collateral Risk Management at Farm Credit Mid-America. For those of you that have seen Dennis teach before, you know this will be worth attending. And for those who have not had the opportunity to see him, we know you will be in for a rewarding educational experience.

The meeting will be held from 8:00 a.m. to approximately 4:00 p.m. with a break for lunch from noon to 1:00 p.m. You are encouraged to bring your own lunch as there are limited facilities around this location. Parking is available.


The meeting will be open to the public; however, if you hold an Arizona real estate appraiser license or certificate you can obtain up to **seven hours of continuing education at no charge**. Attendance for the morning session of the meeting from 8:00 a.m. to noon will satisfy the required attendance for a 4-hour Supervisors and Trainee Appraisers class including the AQB 2015 Criteria as required by the new revised Arizona Revised Statute §32-3614.01 and §32-3614.02. The afternoon will feature a 3-hour Arizona Law class which will include changes to Arizona appraisal statutes resulting from the passage of SB1316 (effective September 13, 2013.)

Some of the Board members will be available for a question and answer period, which may include discussion of potential rule revisions and possible proposed legislation.
